

SAMPLE OF HOMEBOUND REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ Increased weakness.
- ✓ Unsteady gait pattern.
- ✓ Frequent falls.
- ✓ Needs assistance to leave home for safety.
- ✓ Loss of ROM which makes getting into car difficult.
- ✓ Medical restriction due to recent surgery.
- ✓ Medical restrictions due to THR precautions.
- ✓ Medical restrictions due to abdominal problems/surgery. Unable to use a seat belt safely.
- ✓ Severe pain.
- ✓ Assist needed to complete ADL's.
- ✓ Open wound which puts the patient at high risk for infection.
- ✓ Decreased respiratory capacity/high recovery time for oxygenation of blood.
- ✓ SOB with minimal exertion.
- ✓ Unable to climb stairs safely. Stairs present inside/outside of home.
- ✓ Limited cardiac capacity which requires frequent rest periods to recover.
- ✓ Limited activity level which requires frequent rest periods to recover.

- ✓ Severely compromised medical condition which limits community access.
- ✓ Auto immune deficiency which limits community access due to increased health risk.
- ✓ Cancer pt: Actively undergoing radiation/chemo treatments which puts pt at a high risk for infection when accessing the community.
- ✓ Dementia to a level where supervision is necessary.
- ✓ Decreased endurance.
- ✓ Confusion.
- ✓ Multiple gait deviations which places patient at risk for falls.
- ✓ Assist needed on all uneven surfaces.
- ✓ Assist needed on outside surfaces.
- ✓ Unable to transfer independently.
- ✓ Unable to safely leave home unassisted.
- ✓ Requires assistance to ambulate.
- ✓ Dependent upon assistive devices.
- ✓ Assistance required for all activities.
- ✓ Bedbound.
- ✓ Wheelchair bound, unable to push self.
- ✓ Wheelchair bound, does not have ramp.
- ✓ Transfers require Hoyer Lift.
